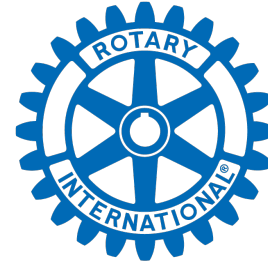

The Hinton Food Bank is a purely volunteer based operation. We believe in “community serving community” and promote respect and dignity when serving our clients. Approximately 3-5% of residents in our community rely on the food bank to help meet their needs, either on an ongoing or temporary basis. Our clients have incomes that do not cover basic living costs. Unfortunately, food banks are needed to bridge this gap.

The Hinton Food Bank provided food to an average of 55 family units/week in 2020##. This represents 135 people assisted weekly..
